Hatricks for the club? That's right, just the one KEN TILSED 4/12 against Roystone in season 76/77.

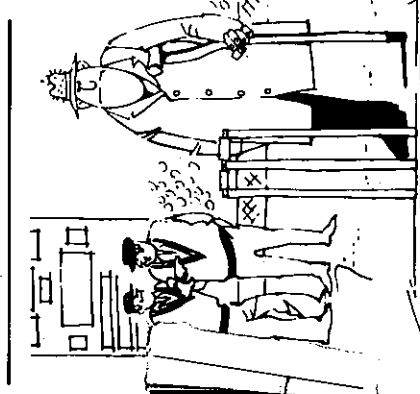
