THE LAST ROUND IN REVIEW

In a closely-fought encounter, the **First Grade** side were unable to finish their campaign with a victory as East Fremantle were successful by 16 runs at Burrendah Reserve.

Having won the toss and batted first, the Crows started well with Rich Soulsby (28) and Elliott (18) adding 45 runs for the first wicket and then Rich Oliver (76), Sav (59) and Sloany (18) all making contributions as the home side posted a competitive score of 8-226.

In reply, East Fremantle made 242, with the skipper taking 3-50 from 16 overs, Sav took 2-30 and Tunni had figures of 2-66. Wickets were also taken by Timmy, Bangers and Sloany.

The **Third Graders** notched up their fifth win for the season with a five wicket win against East Fremantle at Preston Point Reserve. Batting first, the home side were all out for 106 from 22.3 overs as Ali tore through the middle order to take 4-22 from 7 overs and Nav ended with 3-18.

The Crows scored 5-109 from 19 overs in response with Carlos top-scoring with 36, Pushy opened the batting and made 27 and Nick Macek (16) and AJ (10no) also reached double figures.

With both sides unable to make the finals, it was decided to end the match early and not continue on the second day.

The **Seventh Grade** side finished their home and away season with an impressive batting display against Kelmscott, scoring 297 at Rushton Park as the Crows won by 201 runs on the first innings.

The Cats decided to bat first in warm conditions and the Crows dismissed the home side on the verge of tea for 96. Tommy proved to be a handful with 3-28, Jake Landsmeer took 2-13 with his spinners and Simon Acomb finished with 2-18. The ball followed Nev Ram in the field as he held three catches and Keegs took two catches as well.



THE LAST ROUND IN REVIEW

The Crows had their best stint with the bat since Christmas as Nev Ram (172), Simo (27) and Jake (22) saw the Crows through to 2-135 at stumps on day one, before amassing 297 by tea on day two. Trev added 20, but the star was Nev as he made the third highest total by a batsman in club history after Owen Lawton's 192 and Alistair Finnie's 176.

Batting again, Kelmscott made 4-123 from 25 overs, with Motty taking 2-10 from 6, Trev took 1-13 and Andy had 1-29. This weekend sees the Crows travel to Gwynne Park to take on Armadale.

The **One Day As** season came to its conclusion last weekend in a disappointing fashion against the fourth-placed Riverton-Rostrata at Willetton Reserve. The Crows sent the visitors into bat and they made 9-189. Benny Hills (3-19) and Dobbo (3-36) were the pick of the bowlers and Kev Savige held three catches and Evo took two as well.

In reply, the Rats dismissed Willetton for 44, with Evo making an unbeaten 20 batting at number three. The next best batsmen were Kev Savige and Spearsy, who both made five.

The **One Day Es** qualified for the finals in second place and earned a home final after defeating Riverton-Rostrata at Willetton Reserve. Having won the toss and batted, the visitors made 7-158 with Pom (2-11) and Clarkey (2-25) the multiple wicket takers.

The Crows made 4-168 in reply with Livey making an unbeaten 49, Owen Lawton scoring 24 and Faz made 19.
