## “FROM THE NEST”

The 2009-10 season has come to an end, but unfortunately without a premiership to our name. Congratulations to our Seventh Grade side who made the Semi Finals and the One Day Final, as well as the One Day E's who finished the season as runners-up.

One of the highlights of the summer was the club fielding of a fifth side in the newly-created One Day E competition. Despite playing a number of matches without a full side, they finished in second place at the end of the home and away season and reached the Final after their Semi-Final loss was reversed after Phoenix had played an ineligible player in the match. Despite losing in the Final, the players should be proud of their achievements this season.

Congratulations to Geoff Chellew on winning the SMCA One Day E Batting award for 2009-10. 'Lively' scored 562 runs for the side during the season (including his first century for the club) and also took 19 wickets with the ball in a wonderful all-round season. This achievement is all the more special given the fact that he played three matches in Seventh Grade and two matches in the One Day A side.

The AGM was held on March 27 and saw some new blood join the 2010-11 committee. Tim Sewell is the new President, taking over from Ken Savige who decided to stand down after two seasons at the helm and helping to steer the club clear of turbulent times and into First Grade for the first time since 1988-89.

Evan Pappas has traded the financial portfolio for the Vice-Presidency and Andrew Jacob was elected as the club's new treasurer. Ali Saeed replaces Adam Wilson as Secretary and Ali will continue as Registrar until a replacement can be found for the role.

Glenn Dobson and Paul Tunnicliffe will jointly take on the role of Property Managers, with general committee positions being filled by Rob Sims (Sponsorship & Fund Raising), Derek Mott (Publicity & Historical), Nat James and Peter Clarke (Social Events), Ashbeel Sikander and Elliott McLachlan.

The club also inducted its tenth Life Member at the meeting, with Peter Hale joining some illustrious company.

The much awaited Twenty20 match between the 'Aussies' and the 'Rest of the World' was played straight after the AGM and a close contest with the Aussies scraping in by one run. The Aussies made 205 with Simo making 55 retired ... or was he out for a duck ... or was it really windy when the bail came off! Evo was also amongst the runs with 47.

In reply, the Rest of the World made 204 in reply with Rich belting 71 and Tunni made an unbeaten 53.

# THE FINALS IN REVIEW

The **Seventh Grade** side's season came to an end in the Semi-Final as Armadale were successful against the Crows by 110 runs at Gwynne Park.

The Demons won the toss and batted and started well with a 65-run opening partnership before Keegs held a skier from the bowling of Simo. The home side lost five wickets for 19 in their middle order to be 7-135, but some power hitting in the latter overs allowed Armadale to reach 8-223 from their 75 overs.

Motty bowled 22 overs for figures of 3-42, Keegs took 2-16 and Doey finished with 2-36. Simo was also amongst the wickets with 1-33. As well as his two wickets with the ball, Keegs held four catches in the field.

In the Crows' reply on the second day, the inability to compile large partnerships was the team's downfall, with the 34-run stand for the ninth wicket between Kossie and Simon Acomb being the most productive of the innings.

Doey (23, including five boundaries), Charleigh (20), Kossie (20) and Simo (14) all got starts but unfortunately couldn't go on with it and Willetton were dismissed for 113 in 41.2 overs.

The **One Day E** side were surprise winners of their Semi-Final against Phoenix, after losing by 84 runs at Burrendah Reserve. However, Phoenix had played a player who was qualified for a higher grade and the result was overturned and a win by forfeit was declared on the Tuesday after the match.

Phoenix were sent into bat by Della and they scored 4-166 from their 40 overs with Pom finishing with an economical 2-16 from 8 overs and Clarkey took 2-26 from 8 overs. A third wicket partnership of 90 runs was the prime reason for the visitors' competitive total.

In Willetton's innings, the batsmen didn't come to the fore when it was needed and were well on the back foot at 6-49, with Palwinder Singh making 12 of these runs.

## THE FINALS IN REVIEW

Livey was the glue which held the innings together, coming in at 2-31 and remained at the crease until the ninth wicket fell at 80. He made 24 and he scored the only two boundaries of the innings.

The boys commiserated with the Seventh Graders on Sunday night at the Burrendah Tavern, only to receive word of their lucky break two days later. The side was hastily assembled, with the unavailable Talha Khan replaced by Ameet Randika, and the side fronted up to Rushton Park to take on minor premiers Kelmscott.

The home side batted first and asserted their authority on the contest, piling on 5-234 from their overs. Randi was the pick of the bowlers with 3-28 from 8 overs and Pom (1-28) and Palwinder (1-45) also took wickets.

After a handful of overs, the Crows were on the back foot at 2-4, but Livey once again made his presence felt, hitting six fours and a six in his knock of 44. Unfortunately, support for his was once again missing and only Stefan (12) managed to join him in double figures. Willetton were dismissed for 93 in the 26th over to finish runners-up in the One Day E grade for the season.

Considering the fact that the side was hastily cobbled together when the SMCA asked for teams to nominate for the newly-created grade in the second week of the season, and that most weeks saw the side play one or even two short, Della and his band of men can be proud in their achievement of reaching a final this season.
