“FROM THE CROW’S NEST”

The 2010-2011 season started as all seasons do, with a great deal of promise and some very high expectations. We soon found out that things don't always go to plan. The club was let down by a number of senior players who had committed to the club for the season and then reneged on their commitment and moved on to other clubs within the association because the Crows had been relegated from First Grade - a situation brought about predominantly by these players and their poor efforts and lack of commitment to the club.

This said, there were some very exciting things that happened for the club, including our move to Centenary Park for the last half of the season and which now gives us a more permanent home for the coming years on which to build a stronger more successful club.

The club won its first premiership in four years, and did so without having to bowl a ball in the One Day E Grade Final. Whilst it was unusual and a little disappointing that a club would forfeit such a game, it is what it is so congratulations to all the One Day E graders on a fantastic season.

Our Second Grade and One Day B other sides finished fifth and were unlucky not to have secured a place in the finals, whilst our Fourth Grade were unlucky enough to finish with the wooden spoon.

We had a number of significant milestones achieved or passed during the season. Tim Sewell and Evan Pappas both reached the 100 game milestone, which is an indicator of long term dedication to the club. With the bat, Geoff Chellew and Rob Sims both passed the 7000 run milestone, Aiden Sloan topped 2500 runs, club coached Richard Oliver passed 1500 runs and premiership captain James Della Bona went past 1000 runs. The club also played its 1000th player with Michael Gehring receiving this honour.

On the bowling side of the ledger, Rob Sims claimed his 350th wicket, Paul Tunnicliffe took his 250th wicket, Andrew Jacob went past 150 wickets and Ali Saeed bagged his 100th scalp.

The club was also pleased to induct Alan Chellew, Aiden Sloan and Paul Tunnicliffe as Life Members of the club to take the overall tally to 13. These three men have provided loyal and tireless service to the club and this recognition is greatly deserved.

I would like to take this opportunity to congratulate all of last year's award winners. In particular the winners of the four most prestigious awards in any club. The Owen Lawton Medal for the best player in the higher grades was won by Richard Oliver, the John Gibson Medal for the best player in the lower grades went to Pravin Umrani, the Clubman of the Year award was deservedly bestowed on Paul Tunnicliffe, as well as Ben Hills' triumph in the Crab of the Year award.

In Second Grade, Richard Oliver took out the Second Grade batting award, and Paul Tunnicliffe won the bowling trophy. In Fourth Grade, the batting trophy went to Nev Ram and Jake Landsmeer won the bowling award. In the One Day B Grade, Manoj Nihalani (batting) and Pravin Umrani (bowling) were the award winners, whilst in the One Day E side, James Della Bona was the best batsman and Apratim Ghosh Dastidar won the bowling award.

As the incoming President for season 2011-2012, I would like to start by thanking our immediate past president Tim Sewell and his committee for their efforts last season. It's never easy and we always seem to struggle with getting support but as usual we always seem to get through because of the hard work of the committee and a select few who pick up the slack.

SECOND GRADE REVIEW

Returning to Second Grade after an unsuccessful stay in First Grade, the Willetton Crows won five of their eleven matches to finish fifth under new club coach Richard Oliver.

The Crows made a slow start to the season with one win from their first five matches, including narrow losses to Thornlie and Kwinana, who would finish the season below the Crows, as well as eventual premiers Maddington. These losses put Willetton out of finals contention and would prove to be the difference between making and missing the finals.

The highlights were the team's five wins, including the last two on end—the last of those being a nail-biting win over Maddington on the first innings with the visitors just two runs shy of securing an outright win.

Richard Oliver led the way with the bat, scoring two centuries and two fifties in a season tally of 647 runs at 46.21. Fellow import Ben Price hit a fifty in his 351 runs at 21.94 as well as 19 catches and a stumping and Aiden Sloan contributed 182 runs at 15.17.

Paul Tunnicliffe had a stellar season with the ball, taking 28 wickets at 16.43, which included two five wicket hauls and also ten wickets in a match on one occasion (all against Kelmscott). Richard Oliver backed up his batting efforts with 20 wickets at 23.30 and the ever-reliable Tim Sewell finished with 15 wickets at 17.87. The surprise packet with the ball was Aiden Sloan, who claimed 14 wickets at 16.79, including a hat-trick against Kwinana.

The club will be looking to start the 2011-12 season in a similar vein to the way that it finished and it is hoped that the Crows can make their way into the finals. The batsmen need to ensure that they value their wicket highly and the building of partnerships throughout the innings will allow the Crows to post competitive scores on a regular basis. Additionally, the bowlers need to ensure that the opposition are unable to build partnerships to prevent them from seizing the advantage.

FOURTH GRADE REVIEW

The Third Grade side struggled to build any momentum during the season, with only five players playing more than half the season in the side and only two playing ten or more for the side.

It took until the fourth round to notch up the first win of the season against Maddington on the back of an Ashbeel Sikander century, with the only other victory coming in the first home game at Centenary Park in January against East Fremantle. In that match, Australian hockey representative Trent Mitton made an unbeaten 60 and held four catches in his only appearance for the side.

Apart from the Maddington win and the Sikander century, the other main point of note was the hat-trick taken by first year player Michael Gehring against Leeming Spartan.

The batsmen were unable to make challenging totals for the opposition, with only two totals in excess of 200 and ironically they were scored in the Crows' two wins.

Captain Rob Sims scored the most runs with 268 at 20.62 with one half-century, whilst Neville Ram took only three matches to make 160 runs at 40.00, Ashbeel Sikander made 136 runs at 27.20 with a high score of 127 and Vishal Khairnar was the other batsmen to score in excess of 100 runs for the season with 118 at 19.67.

The wily deliveries of Rob Sims allowed him to capture 21 wickets at 17.38, pace bowler Talha Khan and left arm spinner Jacob Landsmeer both took 11 wickets and Indilca Rupasinghe and Anuruwan Rathanayake both finished the season with 10 wickets.

The challenge for the Willetton players this season is to maintain a core group of players who put pressure on the players in the top team for their places in the side. The team of 2010-11 was a relatively young team and if they can go forward as a unit, they improve with experience and prove a tough opponent.

ONE DAY E GRADE REVIEW

The 2010-11 season was a season to remember as the One Day Es became the first Willetton Crows' 4th XI side to win a premiership - the club's 15th title overall.

The season was punctuated by a run of wins that were followed by consecutive losses, but the Crows did enough to finish third in the home and away season. Willetton had difficulty in winning against Kardinya Lakes (three losses), Leeming Spartans (three losses) and Southern River (one win, two losses), but the three sides accounted for all of our eight defeats from 20 matches.

The Semi-Final saw Kardinya Lakes make 9-114 from their allotted overs with Jackson Joseph snaring 4-16 and Trent Mitton finished with figures of 2-20. In reply, Alan Chellew led the charge with an unbeaten 80 as the Crows advanced to the Final after a six wicket win.

Leeming Spartan were unable to field a team for the Final with a number of players being unavailable and not enough qualified players to field a team on the day - an unusual way to win a premiership, but still a premiership nonetheless.

Captain James Della Bona scored the most runs with 350 at 31.82, including three fifties and a highest score of 72 not out. Wicketkeeper and opening batsman Carl Greedy still knows how to make runs with two fifties in a season's tally of 278 at 18.53, as well as claiming 18 catches and a stumping and Trent Mitton scored 232 runs at 77.33 in four matches and scored the side's only century with an unbeaten 100.

Apratim Ghosh Dastidar took 15 wickets at 25.47 to finish with the most wickets, ahead of Tom Bray and Joseph Jackson (both ten wickets) and Wes Milburn, Matt Ferguson and George Papas, who all took nine wickets for the season.

The Crows will be keen to defend their premiership in 2011-12 and most players have signalled their intention to play on for another season.
